Book #3 – Word Collage

Look through magazines for the title of your book. This can be the actual title because you were lucky enough to find an ad for your book, or you can make up the title with individual letters and/or words from these magazines. In the middle of a blank sheet of computer paper, paste your title. After this, return to the magazines and look for words, phrases, sentences, or images (more words than images, please) that illustrate or tell something about your book. As you look, think in terms of the theme, setting, plot line, as well as characters. Work to get about fifty such words, phrases, sentences, or images and paste these onto your paper so that the whole sheet of paper is covered. The visual impact of the collage should tell a potential reader a lot about the book.



When you are done creating your collage, choose 15 of the most prominent words, phrases, sentences, or *images that you chose and copy them onto this paper (*you will need to describe the images in the space provided). After each word, phrase, sentence, or image, in a complete sentence, indicate in the space provided why that particular selection illustrates or tells something about your book.
